Here's the 4-5 lb, naturally shaped Himalayan Salt Lamp I received for review. This photo was taken with the lamp lit in the evening while there was still light out.





According to the Himalayan Salt Shop's [website](#), Himalayan Salt Lamps are made of natural crystal salt mined from the foothills of the Himalayan mountains. It was interesting to learn the natural crystal salt used to make these lamps have been underground for hundred of millions of years and is known to contain special properties and 84 different minerals, including Manganese and Iron. As for the color, it's the Manganese that contributes to the orange/apricot color of the [Himalayan Salt Lamps](#) while the Iron gives the lamp it's reddish color.

Himalayan Salt Lamps can also be good for your health! Each lamp is made from natural crystal salt which are [natural ionizer's](#) that clean the air of pollutants. Here's how it works. The purifying effect of the Himalayan Salt Lamp begins when the lamp is turned on. Once the lamp is turned on, the bulb inside heats up the crystal salt which releases negative ions into the air. Once these negative ions are released, they seek to bond with pollutants in the air. Once the negative ions bond with the pollutants, the newly bonded negative ions become heavier. The excess weight causes the these pollutants to fall to the ground.
